

WCPRD Youth Basketball FAQ

Where do I find the rules of play for the WCPRD basketball league?

What size of basketball and what goal height does my child's age group use?

WCPRD provides basketballs at each practice and game. If you choose to purchase a basketball for your child, the sizes are as follows:

Age Group	Basketball Size	Goal Height
3-4 y/o	22"	6.5'
5-6 y/o	27.5"	8'
7-8 y/o Boys & Girls	28.5"	8.5'
9-10 y/o Boys & Girls	28.5"	8.5'
11-12 y/o Boys	29.5"	10'
11-12 y/o Girls	28.5"	10'
13-14 y/o Boys	29.5"	10'
13-14y/o Girls	28.5"	10'

Can you give me information on uniforms?

WCPRD provides each player with a jersey and shorts. The 3-4 y/o age group will receive a dri-fit t-shirt jersey and shorts. 6U-14U boys and girls will receive a jersey and shorts. Uniforms are typically issued to teams around 1-2 weeks prior to games beginning. Players may only wear rubber-soled sneakers on gym floors.

When will game schedules be available?

Athletic staff members are currently working on game schedules. Those schedules are typically available around two weeks after practice begins.

Where will practices games be located?

Games and practices are located at a combination of the WCPRD gym and school gyms.

When will we receive information on team pictures?

We anticipate releasing picture schedules within a few weeks of the start of practices.

Does WCPRD provide trophies/medals/end-of-season parties?

End-of-season parties/trophies/medals are the responsibility of each team. Coaches will coordinate with parents on whether or not they will provide trophies/medals to players.



What are the playing time requirements for my child's age group?

Age Group	Playing Time Requirement`	
3-4 y/o & 5-6 y/o	2 quarters	
7-8 y/o & up	1 quarter (may combine time b/t all 4 quarters)
